




The Brewin Centre Renovation project



July 2015



Aim of the Project

The renovated centre will provide a warm, welcoming and contemporary space. It will be functional and inviting providing adequate space for the mission of the church and for our wider community.

The Project

The renovation work will be carried out over the next 2-3 years with an estimated cost of £600,000 including a 10% contingency with some of the work being carried out by volunteers. The work will be divided in 7 phases (as shown on the proposed layout plan)

- Phase 1: Ground and first floor toilets, first floor serving kitchen plus second floor renovation in preparation for heating plant.
- Phase 2: Ground floor kitchen, new store in first floor main room.
- Phase 3: New stairwell, new room in courtyard plus roof terrace and heating plant.
- Phase 4: Ground and first floor lobby, accessible toilet and lift.
- Phase 5: Renovation and floor finish in first floor hall.
- Phase 6: Floor insulation, finishes and renovation of remaining areas of ground floor.
- Phase 7: Renovation of Church Street stairwell and first floor store room.



Help and Support
